# Welcome to Malmö

## The third biggest city in Sweden

This is information to you that are an unaccompanied refugee minor. Unaccompanied minor means that you are under 18 years of age and that you are not in the company of your parents or another guardian when you arrive in Sweden. In this leaflet, you will find brief information about what will happen now and to whom you may address to receive proper help.

### The Police

The police help unaccompanied minors to receive proper help at the Swedish border. It is part of their job to see to that nobody gets into trouble and also help to keep law and order.



**Malmö stad**

### The city of Malmö

The city of Malmö helps unaccompanied minors to receive accommodation, a bed to sleep in, safety, food and adults to whom they can talk. The city of Malmö also helps you with health care, should you need it.



**Migrationsverket**

### The National Agency of Migration

Migrationsverket (The National Agency of Migration) is where you will apply for asylum. After you have applied for asylum in Sweden, you are entitled to live in a city in Sweden. It is also there you will go to school.

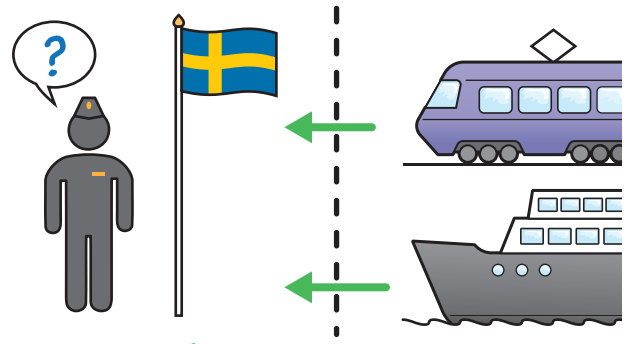

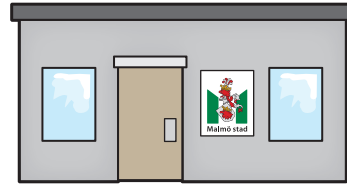
# 1 The Swedish border

- The police asks you how old you are.
- The police helps all unaccompanied minors, that is those that are younger than 18 years and arrive here with parents or another guardian.
- All unaccompanied minors receive help with food, travel to their accommodation, etc.



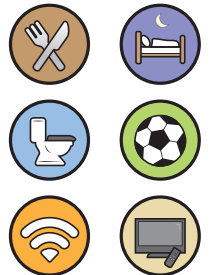
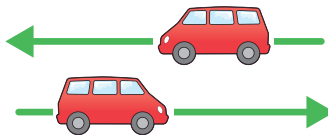
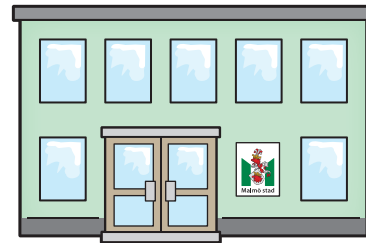
# 2 Waiting area for unaccompanied minors

- Here you will receive something hot to drink and some small snack. We also have Wi-Fi connection to the internet and toilets here.
- You will receive a form, where your name must be written.
- You will have to wait for some hours here, until a bus or car will pick you up.



# 3 Waiting area for unaccompanied minors that will receive temporary accommodation

- Here you will receive a reference number, that will entitle you to a temporary accommodation.
- We will write more information into your form, so that we may help you as good as possible, for instance your age and which languages you speak.
- You will have to wait for some hours here, until a bus or car will pick you up.



# 5 Migrationsverket (The National Agency for Migration)

- You will be transported to "Migrationsverket", where you can apply for asylum in Sweden.
- This is where you will leave your finger prints and will be registered as applicant for asylum in Sweden. It will entitle you to stay in Sweden while your application is being handled. After you have applied for asylum in Sweden, you will have the right to live, go to school and travel in Sweden.
- You will have to wait here some hours before it is your turn to be apply for asylum. After that, you will be transported to your temporary accommodation.

# 4 Temporary accommodation

- Here you will receive a bed, shower, simple clothes, food and will also meet adults with whom you can talk. Often there is also television, some sort of leisurely activity and Wi-Fi connection to the internet.
- You will stay here until it is decided where in Sweden you will live and go to school.

# 6 Living while your application for asylum is being handled

- You will be travelling to the place in Sweden, where you will live while your application for asylum is being handled by "Migrationsverket".
