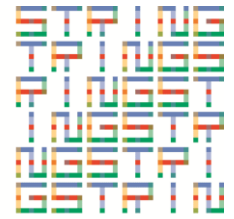

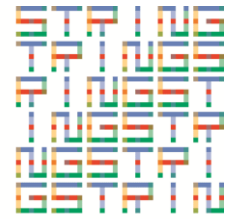

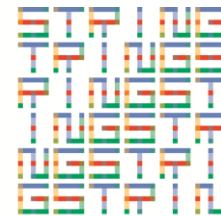

EU-offices' recommendation to STRING secretariat concerning EIP

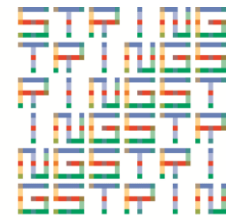
2014:

February – Political forum backed the idea of STRING secretariat committing under the EIP in June

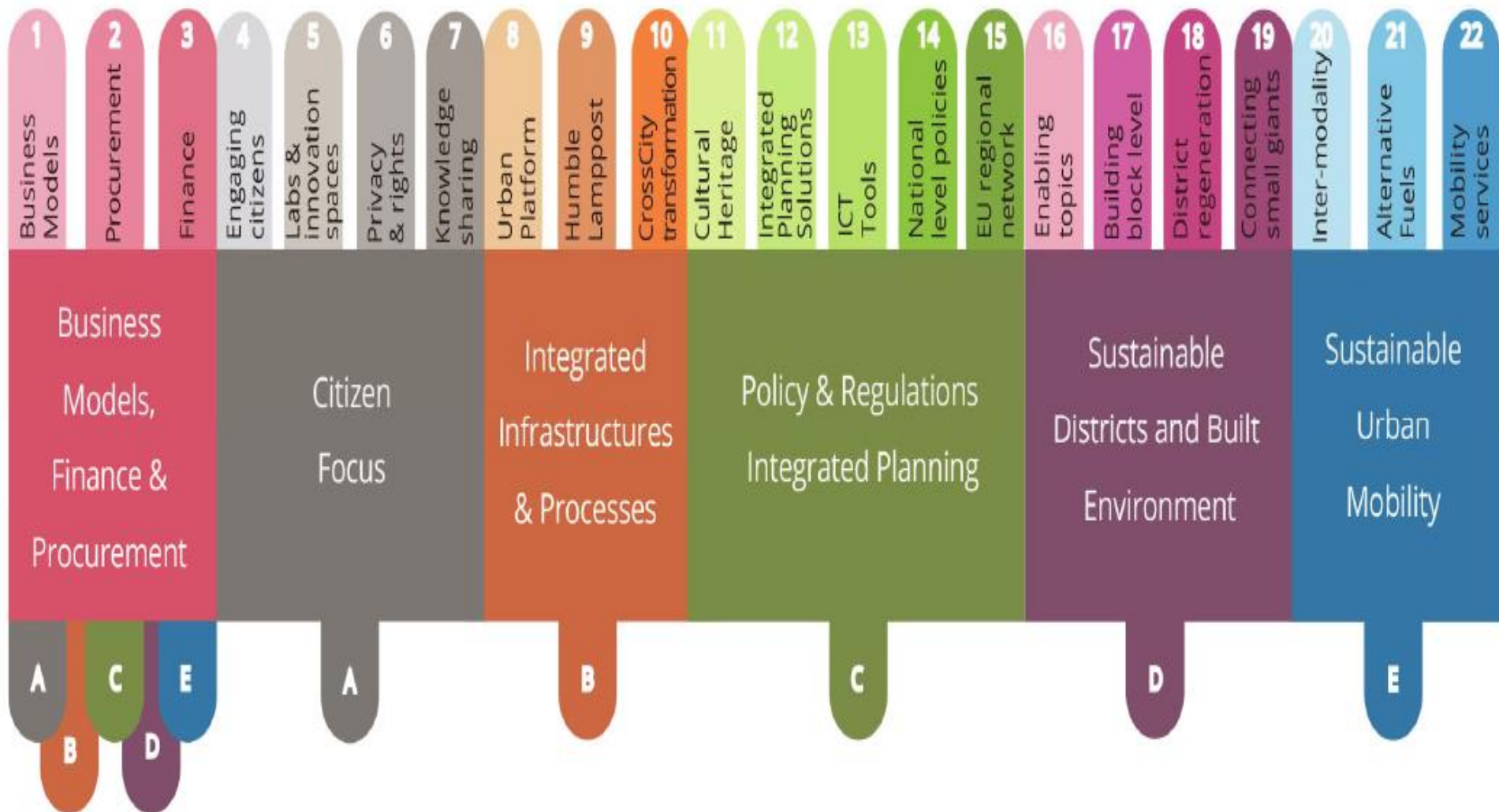
June – application for commitment sent, accepted

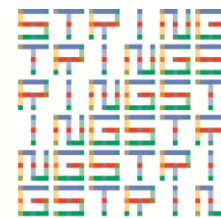
October – Kick-off meeting of EIP in Brussels
